

MEN'S RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT

NEW OUTLOOK: A program designed to meet the recovery needs of men. New Outlook is located in the rolling hills of Belmont County, Ohio. It establishes a shared living environment for adult chemically dependent men. This abstinence-based program focuses on assisting men in developing a lifestyle free from mood-and mind-altering chemicals. It provides clients with an approach to recovery in which they have the opportunity to influence change in their own lives.

INNOVATION IN TREATMENT

Our residential treatment programs accomplish the goal of enhancing the chemically dependent individual's desire to become drug-free by teaching skills needed to approach life in a new way. Our shared-family-style settings provide individualized treatment. Variable lengths of stay are considered in order to meet each client's specific needs. Skills development for a drug-free lifestyle is provided along with referrals to sober support meetings, recreation, parenting, case management, and educational and vocational involvement.

FLEXIBLE FEE SCALE

Crossroads Counseling Services recognizes a variety of economic backgrounds for prospective residential clients. A fee scale has been designed to address individual needs. Self-payment, Medicaid, and most private health plans are accepted.

DISCHARGE PLANNING

Residents nearing the end of treatment phase will develop plans for continuing recovery. Our clinical team and care management team will assist each resident to establish community resources and aftercare planning.
